Thank you for giving Hamill Creek Timberwrights the opportunity to submit a proposal for the He Hale Mahucona. We have based this proposal on the drawings which you provided to us.

The grade of Douglas fir that we are proposing to use for this project is an Export R List C & better clear. R List is the highest possible export grade of wood and is normally considered as close to perfect as one can get. The timbers and decking will have a medium to fine grain and be cut from old growth logs. In a vertical grain piece that is medium to fine grain typically has between 6 to 10 growth rings per inch. All of the timbers will be cut free of heart center. Even with the use of this high grade of wood, checking, sap wood, pitch pockets, and a few well spaced knots, are still possible.

A lead time of 5– 6 months is required to source the material, cut, and ship the timber frame. Once again we thank you for giving Hamill Creek Timberwrights the opportunity to submit a proposal for your new home .I look forward to your response.
